Keri Latimer is a Winnipeg-based composer, songwriter, and thereminist whose music blends prairie-rooted storytelling with dreamlike, off-kilter textures. Best known as the voice behind the alt-folk project **Leaf Rapids** (and formerly the Juno-winning band **Nathan**), she creates work that feels both grounded and slightly sideways.

Her film and TV work includes contributing music to the **Academy Award–nominated feature *Frozen River***, as well as scores for shorts, features, and interdisciplinary projects. Combining voice, theremin, and textural electronics, she builds emotional worlds that drift between intimate and experimental. She has appeared as a featured soloist with the **Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra**, including the Canadian premiere of Björk’s *Family* for strings. Under her experimental moniker **ÓFukami**.
